The Certified Professional Builder (CPB) program is administered by the Oklahoma



State Home Builders Association and is the only one of its kind in the state of Oklahoma.

This voluntary certification program for home builders was

established to recognize professionals in the home building industry.

The term "professional" is used to describe the manner in which a CPB conducts business and the process the builder follows in delivering your new home. The Certified Professional Builder certification program is truly wise for both the home builder and consumer.

WHY CHOOSE A CERTIFIED PROFESSIONAL BUILDER?

Because buying or building a new home is probably the largest investment one will ever make, it makes sense to choose a home builder who has an investment in their profession.

Certified Professional Builders have made that investment by agreeing to meet certain standards and criteria. CPBs are required to:

- Meet membership requirements of their local home builders association, including appropriate experience and credit criteria
- Comply with all appropriate Oklahoma statutes concerning residential contractors
- Provide evidence of Worker's Compensation Insurance and general liability coverage in an amount set forth by the Oklahoma State Home Builders Association
- Provide each homeowner with a written warranty of not less than one year.

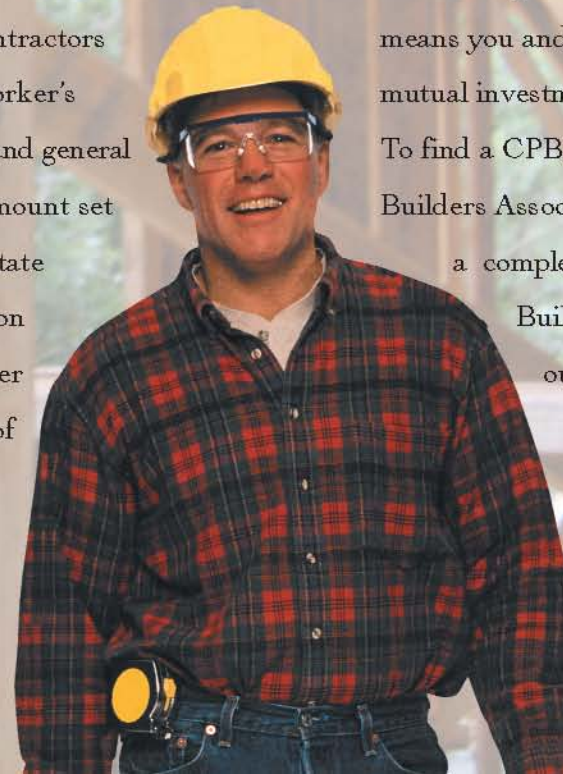
- Build in compliance with appropriate local, state and national building codes

- Adhere to the Code of Ethics of the National Association of Home Builders

- Complete nine credits of continuing education annually
